Eutrichapion viciae var. rufinasus or a a separate subspecies?

1%-2% deviation in the mtCO1 gene from the nominate form E. viciae (Paykull, 1800), and the orange-red tip of the rostrum, which all male specimens in Cyprus have, suggest that this is in fact the subspecies *E. viciae rufinasus* (Desbrochers des Loges, 1891) and not just a variant of the *Eutrichapion* species.
