Alziar (2023): Doubts about the species status of Larinus ursus in Cyprus!

"Larinus sp. (nec ursus Fabricius, 1792). The Cypriot specimens do not correspond in any way to the typical Western European ursus from where it was initially described by Fabricius. They belong to the group of Near Eastern species; we could relate them in particular to L. albolineatus Capiomont, 1874, from Egypt and Israel; despite a visit to the collections of the National Museum in Paris and reading the article by GÜLTEKIN & PERRIN (2018) the real taxonomic affiliation still requires some investigation."
